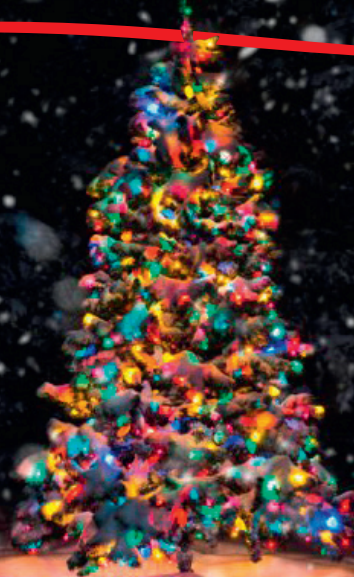


Christmas is coming...
